EXTERIOR LIGHTING

DESIGN GUIDELINES

- 1. Summary:
 - a. This section provides guidelines and standards for Exterior Lighting.
- 2. Design:
 - a. Parking lot and pedestrian walkway site lighting:
 - All parking lot lighting fixtures, walkway bollards or other pedestrian walkway lighting shall have fusing at each individual pole or bollard.
 - b. Use LED exterior fixtures. A mockup of the fixture and approval from the owner must be obtained before installing.

 - b. Conduits, Fittings and Boxes
 - c. Lighting Controls

EQUIPMENT and PRODUCT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Lighting Fixtures
 - a. Approved Manufacturers:
 - As approved by owner.
 - Refer to the attached examples of a preferred exterior wall pack fixture and a
 pole-mounted area light used on past projects. It is the designer's responsibility
 to specify and confirm with lighting manufacturers for the most current series of
 fixtures similar in style.
