Traffic Update for Duncan/Newstead Intersection Closure

We are aware that commutes Wednesday afternoon and this morning were especially hectic resulting from the Duncan/Newstead intersection closure. It was anticipated that the closing would disrupt traffic, especially during the first days and weeks as commuters adjust their routes.

The parking, public safety and construction teams are continuing to work together diligently to monitor intersections and traffic flow and take action to reduce the impact. Starting this afternoon, the following measures are in effect:

- Public safety officers will be located at high-volume intersections during peak times to help with traffic flow.
- Gates to the SLCH garage will be raised to enable faster entry and exit.
- Detour signs designating Left Turn Only are being installed at the exit of the SLCH garage onto Duncan. A Right Turn Only sign is at the exit to Newstead.

Additional locations for signs have been identified and the signs are ordered.

Staff are encouraged to explore alternate routes and consider carpooling or taking MetroLink/MetroBus. Please allow for extra time for your commute.

The parking, public safety and construction teams will continue to monitor the situation. We appreciate your patience as everyone adjusts to new temporary traffic patterns.

Development at the Medical Center is unprecedented. The inconveniences are short term and will result in a better experience as early as this summer, when much of the work in the streets is completed.
