Fair St. Louis Traffic Congestion This Weekend – Plan Ahead on Commute

Fair St. Louis will take place in Forest Park from 5 pm on Thursday, July 2nd to Saturday, July 4th. Thousands of people are expected to flock to the area each day for free concerts and events. Employees scheduled to work during that time should expect road closures and heavy traffic and should plan accordingly.

Road closures

Traffic congestion and alternate routes could add significant time to your commute. While Kingshighway is expected to remain open, traffic will likely be heavy.

As an alternative to Kingshighway:

- Employees traveling to work westbound via I-64/40 may wish to take the Forest Park Avenue or the Boyle Avenue exits;
- Employees traveling to work eastbound via I-64/40 may wish to take the Tower Grove exit.

Public transportation/MetroLink

All methods of public transportation will experience increased usage during the three-day event which may cause crowding and delays. Please plan accordingly.

Parking: WUSM Employees

All parking facilities serving the Washington University School of Medicine (except Lot L) will remain available for standard employee parking.

Parking: Fair St. Louis attendees

- Public parking will be available on park grounds for visitors to Fair St. Louis for \$20.
- July 3rd and 4th, employees and the general public will have free access to the CAB southeast lot and the WUSM lot L at Newstead/Duncan. *Fair Saint Louis will be running shuttles from this lot.

Parking: Patients

Patients will have access to all patient parking areas. However, the Forest Park/Laclede Garage will only be accessible from Laclede Ave.
