## Portion of EH&S/Central Services Drive/Sidewalk Blocked – Dates Revised

A directional boring machine will block a portion of the EH&S drive on **Monday, November 16<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>** to install a new fiber optic conduit from the CID Dorm building to the corner of Euclid and Clayton Avenues. Trucks will still be able to enter and exit the drive, just not at the same time.

A small portion of the sidewalk will also be closed just west of the EH&S service drive entrance on Clayton Avenue and on the north side of Clayton Avenue near the intersection with Euclid Avenue to accommodate the start and the end of the directional bore.

## H Lot at 4480 Clayton Avenue Closed for Repairs

The H Lot at 4480 Clayton Avenue (east of building) is scheduled for repair starting Wednesday, November 18<sup>th</sup>. There will be a large portion of the eastern and southern sections of the lot blocked off. The block off will move as needed during the project.

The lot will be closed to all parking starting at 10pm on Friday, November 20<sup>th</sup> until Monday, November 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5am. The lot will be sealed and striped. Vehicles remaining on lot will be towed at owner's expense.

Parkers that are displaced during the repairs should park in the Clayton Garage. Parkers should pull a ticket when entering Clayton Garage and exit with the attendant. Parkers will need to fill out the information on back of entry ticket. Parkers will not be charged for parking during the duration of the project.

The work is weather dependent and subject to change. Signage will be posted.
