Crane Lift - Mallinckrodt/Southwest Tower

A crane lift for equipment installation onto the 5th floor of the Mallinckrodt Building will affect the occupancy of the Southwest Tower on Saturday, April 16th. Crews will arrive and begin setting up a crane in the alley between Southwest Tower and Queeny Tower at about 5am.

The first lift of the day is scheduled to begin at about 8am and operations are expected to continue until approximately 2pm. During the course of the day, the crane is scheduled to lift objects over the top of Southwest Tower about four different times. Each time the lift occurs, the top floors of Southwest Tower and adjacent areas, including the pedestrian walkway between Queeny Tower and Southwest Tower, will have to be clear of all personnel.

Southwest Tower occupancy will be limited during the course of the lift due to safety concerns. Floors 9, 10, 11, and the roof are affected.

Please plan to be out of the affected areas during the course of this project.

Revised - Hope Plaza Reflecting Pool Cleaning

Due to an event next week in Hope Plaza, the project to clean the Reflecting Pool will begin on Monday, April 18th. This project will consist of draining the pool, removing the lily pads, cleaning the pool and then replacing the water and lily pads. The project should be completed by Friday, April 22nd but the work is weather permitting.

Temporary Road Closures due to GO! St. Louis Marathon

The 2016 GO! St. Louis Marathon will take place on Sunday, April 10th. There will be several temporary road closures during the race. Most of these closures will take place at approximately 7am until 2pm.

Forest Park Blvd. will be closed in both directions west of Euclid Ave. and east of Spring Ave.

The eastbound lane of Forest Park Blvd. will remain open between Euclid Ave. and Spring Ave. for the duration of the race.

Clayton Ave. will be closed west of Taylor Ave.
