McKinley Avenue Street Closure

Starting Saturday, September 24 at 6am, we will be shutting down both lanes of traffic on McKinley Avenue between Euclid Avenue and the east end of the Biomedical Computing Laboratory (BCL) Building to make repairs to the steam vaults in the street. We are expecting to re-open one lane, one-way of traffic flowing west towards Euclid by 5am on Tuesday, October 4.

After final repairs are made to the steam piping in the vault, we will re-open all lanes of traffic on McKinley. We expect this to happen on Wednesday, October 12. During this entire time frame, workers will be making the same repairs simultaneously on the corner of McKinley and Euclid on the grassy knoll just to the west side of BCL. The “B” lot will remain open at all times while this project is underway but will only be accessible via Clayton Avenue using the EH&S dock entrance or westbound McKinley Avenue.

This schedule is weather dependent and could be extended due to inclement weather. Please [see photos](#) for more information.

Partial Link Closure

From 6am on Saturday, September 24 until 4am on Wednesday, November 30, there will be a partial closure of the link at the tie in between the new link and the existing link

Temporary Closure of BJCIH Loading Dock

On Saturday, October 1 from 6am to 6pm, the service drive from Taylor Avenue to the BJCIH loading dock will be closed in order to allow stone channel installation on the side of the MCC building. Pedestrian traffic will not be affected by this shutdown.

Work on the Link Will Close Taylor Avenue for Three Weekends

Sent on Behalf of BJH:

Construction of the link connecting employee parking with the main campus will require Taylor Avenue to close for three consecutive weekends starting Friday evenings and reopening Sundays evenings. Construction equipment will be in the street enabling contractors to work over Taylor.

In addition, the employee parking access road south of the garages will be closed all day Saturday and Sunday the same weekends. Access in and out of Duncan Central garage will be from Duncan Avenue only. SLCH staff garage is not affected.

Starting Fridays at 6pm, there will be limited through traffic on Taylor, with complete closure by 7pm, on the following dates:

Friday, September 30, reopening 6pm, Sunday, October 2

Friday, October 7, reopening 6pm, Sunday, October 9

Friday, October 14, reopening 6pm, Sunday, October 16

Access will be maintained to all buildings, parking lots and streets off Taylor Avenue. Detours will be marked. Metro buses will be rerouted to enter the Metro bus terminal from the north only.
