## **Cortex Metrolink Station renderings**

The new Cortex Metrolink station will be constructed east of Boyle, just south of the @4240 building. The station will also include a new bike bath on the north side that has been jointly designed with Great Rivers Greenway.

The construction of the station is scheduled to start on June 14, 2017 and will be complete and in operation by 2018.

## **Lane restriction and traffic delay on MCC south service drive tomorrow**

On Saturday, June 10 from 6am to 12pm, a lift will be used on the south service drive of the MCC building to caulk a trim piece just below the third story glass. The work will only be done from the center point of the building to the far southwest corner. The lift will be positioned in the road with extended axles that will restrict through traffic until the axles are retracted to allow passage. The wait time should not exceed more than 3-5 minutes for passing vehicles. There will be cones set up to keep pedestrian traffic out of work areas.
